

Guidelines of participation for *In Focus 2024*

Exhibition Dates

Friday 1 November 2024 – Sunday 19 January 2025

Redland Art Gallery at RPAC Mezzanine (Redland Performing Arts Centre), Cleveland

Overview

Performance is embedded in the visual arts as witnessed through historical art movements Impressionism, Abstraction and Pop Art. *In Focus 2024* will centre on the theme, 'Performance'. This broad concept asks artists to consider the visual qualities to document, evoke, reminisce and capture the essence of performance. Performance can be music, theatre, dance and comedy, in all the various forms. Read AGNSW Curator Nicholas Chambers essay 'Looking at Music and Listening to art' [<https://www.artgallery.nsw.gov.au/art/watch-listen-read/read/music-art/>] for inspiration as he explores how Australian artists over the decades have sought to respond to music performance. Local artists are encouraged to interact with performance venues for inspiration.

Artwork Requirements

- Two-dimensional works must be on a 21 x 29.5cm support with a maximum depth of 2cm. Works can be portrait or landscape orientation and must be unframed.
- Three-dimensional works must not exceed 21cm wide x 29.5cm deep x 50cm high.
- Two artworks may be submitted for consideration. Artworks not selected will be returned to the artist.
- Artworks must have been completed after 1 January 2024 and not been exhibited elsewhere.
- All artworks are to be clearly labelled with artist's name, address and title of work.
- Each artwork must be accompanied by a completed loan agreement.

Installation, Insurance and Selection of Artworks

- RAG will cover insurance for artworks while they are at RAG. A loan agreement must be completed with each artwork, otherwise insurance will not be possible.

Sale of Artworks

- The standard RAG commission of 20% will apply to any artwork sold.
- Price of artwork provided by artist on the loan agreement must include GST, if applicable.
