TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

The *Redland Art Awards* is a biennial contemporary painting competition.

Entries are open to artists who are Australian citizens or permanent residents, who currently reside in Australia, and are aged 18 years or over at the opening of the prize on **Tuesday 5 May, 2026**.

In 2026 the *Redland Art Awards* primary award is an acquisitive prize of \$20,000.

In 2026 the *Redland Art Awards* second prize is \$6,000 and the third prize is \$3,000. Additionally, there is the Meredith Foxtton People's Choice Award, proudly sponsored by Redland Yurara Art Society Inc, of \$1,000 and the RAMP Member's Choice Award of \$500.

ENTRY SPECIFICATIONS

Entries are restricted to paintings in liquid media such as oil, acrylic, watercolour, pastel or gouache. Paintings with mixed media are permitted but must consist of a minimum of 50% painting in liquid media, with the percentages being noted and specified on the entry form. Photographs, drawings, prints, 3D works, multi-media, digital and video works do not qualify for entry. Entries which do not contain at least 50% painting in liquid media or are found to contain offensive or illegal subject matter will not be accepted.

Paintings must be the original work of the artist and must not infringe on the copyright, moral rights or other rights of another person.

Paintings must be framed, stretched or on a rigid backing, ready for hanging with D-rings attached. (Distance between top of ring to top of frame = 7.5cm (75mm)).

Paintings must not exceed 2m (2000mm) in height, 1.5m (1500mm) in width and a maximum depth of 10cm (100mm) (including framing). Paintings must not weigh more than 10 kilograms. Paintings which do not conform to size or weight restrictions will not be accepted.

Paintings must have a completion date no earlier than 1 January 2025.

Paintings must not have won a prize in any other competition. If the artist is notified that the painting has won another award after submission to the *Redland Art Awards 2026*, the artist must notify Redland Art Gallery immediately, and the painting will be removed from the prize.

ENTRY INTO THE PRIZE

Artists may enter up to three paintings for consideration. If more than one painting is entered by an artist, **only one painting may be selected for final judging**, if selected at all.

Each painting must be accompanied by the entry fee, a CV of the artist of not more than one page, plus a brief statement about the painting submitted (approximately 100 words). Please note that text provided may be edited or may not be included in the final exhibition. Paintings must be labelled clearly on the back with artist's name, title of painting and date (year) of completion.

Entry fees are non-refundable and inclusive of GST:

Payment can ONLY be made online via the Redland Art Awards website and may be subject to credit card surcharge. An electronic receipt will be provided.

JUDGING

The *Redland Art Awards* are judged by a Panel of three industry representatives and a Lead Judge. The Panel conducts blind judging from digitally submitted images and compiles a list of Finalists.

The Lead Judge will conduct in-person judging of the Finalist works, selecting the winner and runners up. This selection will not be judged blind.

On Wednesday 14 October 2026 artists will be notified via email of the results of the first stage of judging. Finalists will also be listed on the website including their name, state, title of painting and date (year) of painting.

The primary acquisitive award, runner up awards and the RAMP Member's Choice Award will be announced at the opening night event of the *Redland Art Awards* on Friday 27 November 2026, and on the *Redland Art Awards* website and Redland Art Gallery's social media channels by Monday, 30 November 2026.

The Meredith Foxtton People's Choice Award will be announced on the *Redland Art Awards* webpage and Redland Art Gallery's social media channels on Friday 22 January 2027.

Only paintings selected for the Finalist exhibition will be displayed at Redland Art Gallery.

Finalist exhibition paintings must be displayed for the entire duration of the exhibition, from Sunday 29 November 2026 – Friday 22 January 2027.

Finalists consent to their paintings being reproduced in print and electronic media, and in the advertising and promotion for current and future *Redland Art Awards*.

Finalists consent for their name, state, title of painting, date (year) of painting completion and entry number to be listed on the *Redland Art Awards* website, artwork labels and other print and electronic media.

SALES

Paintings selected for the Finalist exhibition may be offered for sale.

If paintings are to be offered for sale, their price and GST (if applicable) must be listed on the entry form.

Redland Art Gallery will refer sales enquires back to the artist, or their gallery representative (if listed on the entry form).

Redland Art Awards 2026 - TERMS AND CONDITIONS (continued)

FREIGHT

Paintings selected for the Finalist exhibition must be transported to and from Redland Art Gallery by the artist or their authorised representative.

Any charges associated with transporting the paintings to and from Redland Art Gallery is payable by the artist.

Paintings selected for the Finalist exhibition must arrive at Redland Art Gallery between Monday 2 November and Thursday 12 November 2026.

Paintings are required to be collected by the artist or their authorised representative at the completion of the Finalist exhibition, between Thursday 28 and Friday 29 January 2027.

Should an artist fail to collect their painting, Redland Art Gallery may sell or dispose of the work in a manner deemed appropriate by the Redland Art Gallery (Redland City Council).

INSURANCE

Redland Art Gallery (Redland City Council) will insure the paintings from time of receipt until their collection between Thursday 28 and Friday 29 January 2027 (unless alternative delivery or collection arrangements are agreed upon prior). Artists must insure their work whilst in transit to and from Redland Art Gallery.
